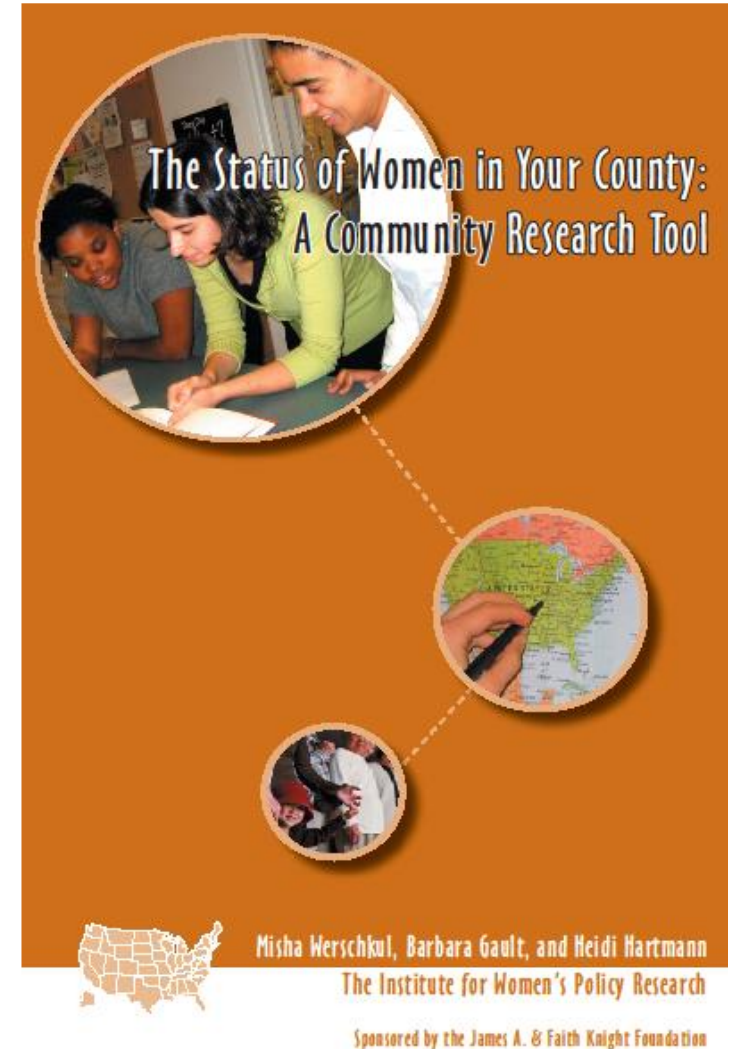

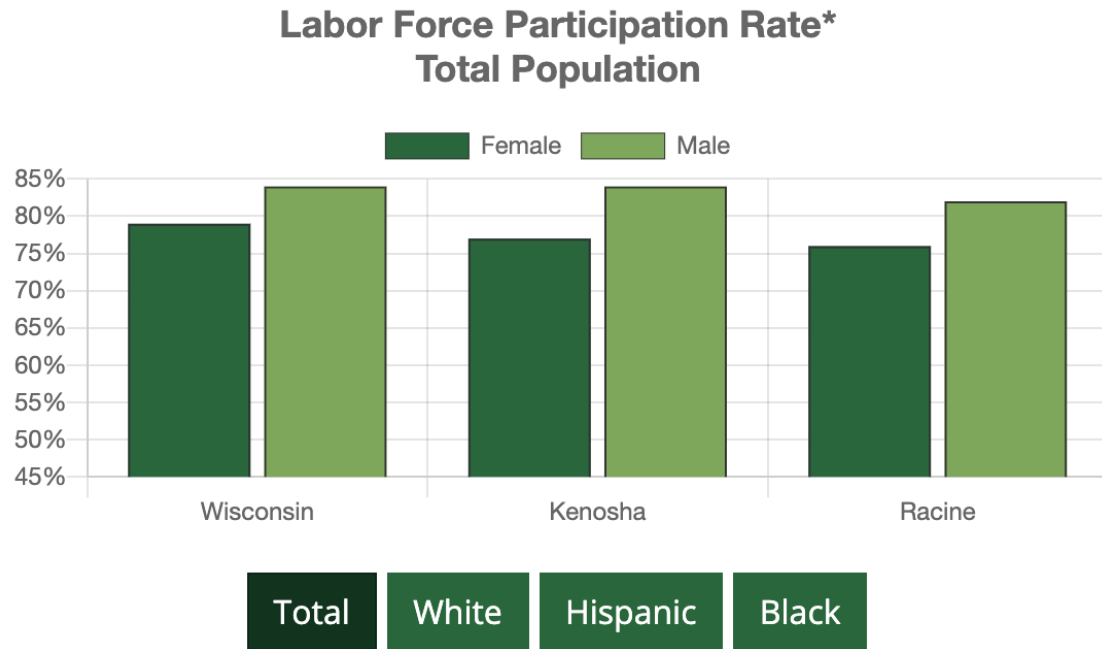

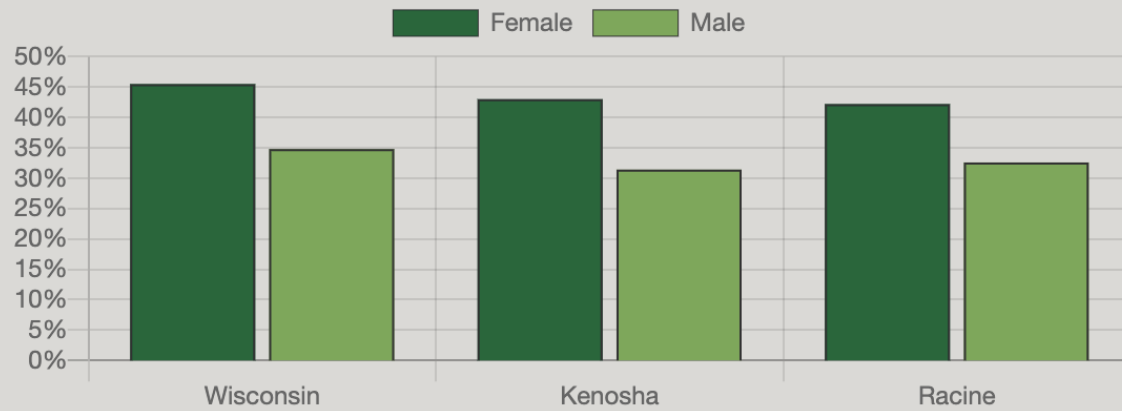

Total White Hispanic Black

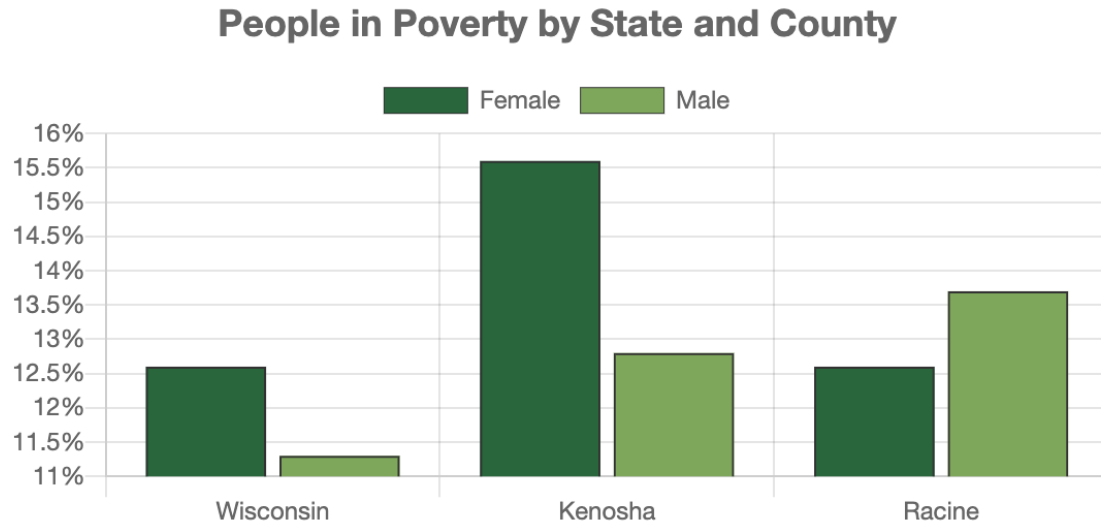
