
### **TOP PRIORITIES CONCERNING EDUCATION:**

## **ACTION PLAN: Communicate with Your Legislators**



How to speak with your legislator - AAUW WI Public Policy AAUW Wisconsin • 34 views • 2 months ago

- Send introduction email or letter
- Call to set up an appointment in your district home office or at the Capitol in person or via Zoom ( you may be meeting with intern or staff member)
- Research your legislator and his/her position on issues
- Develop a "cheat sheet" or talking points you wish to emphasize with legislator

### ACTION PLAN: Communicate with Your Legislators CONTINUED



How to speak with your legislator - AAUW WI Public Policy AAUW Wisconsin • 34 views • 2 months ago

- Make your "ask"- what is it you want your legislator to do
- Ask legislator if he/she can support this request
- Leave resource materials for legislator
- Reiterate ask before leaving and then thank legislator
- Follow up with an email or letter thanking your legislator for their time and for listening to your perspective
