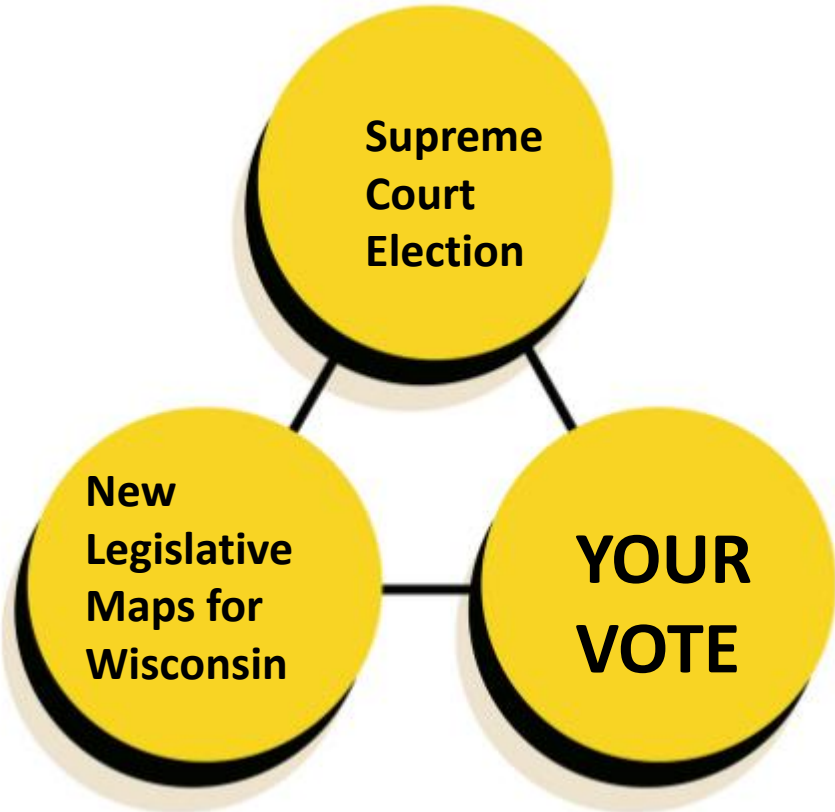




# FAIR MAPS SUCCESS

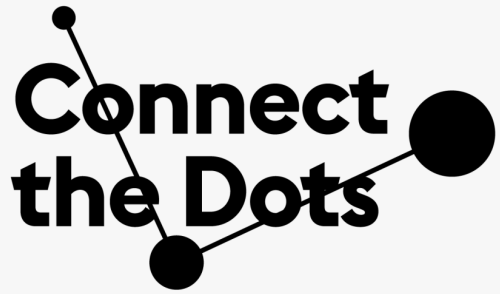


“A New Day in Wisconsin”
